



Consultation on proposed Admission Arrangements for Wescott Infant School for entry into Reception from September 2026

Introduction

Wescott Infant School is an academy school. The Circle Trust is the admission authority for the school. When an admission authority wishes to make changes to their admission arrangements, they must consult to ensure all views are heard. We are proposing to amend the admission arrangements for Wescott Infant School to reduce the Pupil Admission Number (PAN). The Circle Trust is consulting on changes to the admission arrangements for Wescott Infant School, for which the main change is as follows:

Proposed changes to the oversubscribed criteria:

- Proposed change to reduce the Pupil Admission Number (PAN) from 56 to 30

Why are we proposing these changes?

With the lower birth rate on the area, Wescott Infant School wishes to seek comments from the public on a proposal to reduce their PAN. A reduction in PAN will help Wescott provide stability in their long-term planning, including the set-up of the school and budget planning. With many schools in the area affected by the demographic changes, the Local Authority have also asked schools locally to reduce their PANs and Wescott are looking to play their part.
